## Your step by step guide to hosting a Conversation for Animals

- Get together with a group of friends or family for a conversation.

  It could be your monthly book club, at the park while your kids are playing, after a religious service or over a coffee.
- Use the conversation cards included in this toolkit to get started.

  Begin with the introduction card. This will explain Animal Futures:

  The Big Conversation and get the discussion going.
- Choose your first theme. There is a separate conversation card for each theme which includes a description and questions. As you're discussing, use your response sheet to take notes (you may want to refer to these later).
- If you have time to chat more, you can choose any of the remaining three themes to discuss. Again, use the conversation card to guide your discussion and the response sheet to take notes. Repeat this for all the themes you'd like to discuss.
- After your conversation don't forget to share your group's reflections and ideas with us.
